

GFC Admission Standards Committee

Number of Meetings: Report to GFC as required. This committee meets very regularly and is a very heavy commitment. Each meeting generally lasts a couple of hours.

1. To be governed by the principles according to which both admissions of persons to the University as students and transfer credit evaluation are managed as follows:
 - a. Academic excellence.
 - b. Potential for success in pursuit of academic excellence.
 - c. Identification and consideration of applicants or groups of applicants with special needs to characteristics, who evidence the potential for success in the pursuit of academic studies.
 - d. Fairness, consistency and appropriateness of transfer credit evaluation.
2. To make decisions regarding the admission of students under these principles in the light of institutional capacities, resources and other factors which may be appropriate to consider.
3. To make decisions regarding transfer evaluation across the University in a manner consistent with these principles.
4. To report to GFC as required.
