Number of Meetings: Frequency is Variable. This committee meets very heavy in the fall semester.

1. Receive and consider proposals from Faculty Councils regarding academic regulations (including examination policy), program requirements, and curriculum changes, and make recommendations concerning these matters to GFC.
2. Receive and consider policy proposals regarding admissions and transfer credit, and make recommendations concerning these matters to GFC.
3. With respect to all matters cited in a) and b), on its own account and as it may be deemed useful, communicate with and make recommendations to the Faculty/ School Councils.
4. With respect to all matters cited in a) and b), determine areas of common concern, coordinate inter-unit interests, and make recommendations concerning these matters to the Faculty/ School Councils.
5. Recommend to GFC through UPC the establishment of new credit programs other than proposals for graduate programs.
6. Propose policies governing the publication of all official University calendars.
7. Develop procedures for the coordination, preparation, and publication of University calendars, including the final authorization of text.
