

GFC Honorary Degrees Committee

Number of meetings: 2-3 times during the year.

“At least once per year, the GFC Honorary Degrees Committee invites nominations of persons who reflect outstanding academic accomplishment and exemplify the University of Lethbridge philosophy. Nominations must be accompanied by an appropriate supporting dossier. “

1. Solicit nominations for honorary degree recipients representative of outstanding academic accomplishment consistent with the University's philosophy.
2. To review nominations and conduct research on each nomination as required, in order to determine whether or not each nomination meets the standards developed by the Committee, who shall act on behalf of General Faculties Council in placing the nomination before the Senate
3. To select, from those candidates approved by the Committee, one candidate for each Spring and Fall Convocation, and to submit both names to the Senate Honorary Degrees Committee, by the Senate established date, all material related to the nominations including the G.F.C. Honorary Degree Committee's recommendation. It is understood that the G.F.C. Honorary Degrees Committee may decide not to make a nomination or nominations to Senate in anyone year.
